### SMALL ACTS

Greatness lies in the "little" gestures that the Gospel indicates as the way of God's Kingdom, especially when oriented to the "little ones".



### REGULARITY

Little gestures of kindness exercised with regularity form virtue and the sustained rhythm in life builds character in persons.



### ROOTED IN THE LOVE OF GOD AND NEIGHBOR

Love of God poured generously into our hearts serves as the primary motive for action to love back and the commitment to be men and women for others.



### EMPOWERMENT OF THE COMMUNITY

"Givers" and "receivers" are both transformed by their habit of love and goodness, and empowered as well to be responsible agents of social transformation.



## OUR WORK



### NUTRITION AND HEALTH

Programs or projects designed for improved and health conditions in poor communities.



### LIVELIHOOD DEVELOPMENT

Group enterprise development that could generate employment and income for the poor.



### EDUCATION

Alternative and formal learning for underprivileged individuals.



### HOUSING

Decent housing to poor families who have acquired security of tenure but are unable to meet housing needs. Bridge-financing for land acquisition or purchase may also be considered.



### DISASTER RESPONSE

Initiatives that respond to the outreach of victims of calamities and disaster.
